Option II : PAAS/IAAS Model

- Minimum commitment for this service shall be 1 year

- OS & DB maintenance including patch updates
- Data backups
- End users’ management & support
- Hardware maintenance & monitoring if the hardware is provided by ISVs
- Maintenance of ISVs own network

SERVICE ACCESS FEES FOR CLIENTS OF ISVS

- Each Client will be charged minimum US\$500pm
- ISVs will be responsible for payment of these fees
- Fees are calculated monthly and payable on quarterly basis
